The Cascode Amplifier. While the C-B (common-base) amplifier is known for wider bandwidth than the C-E (common-emitter) configuration, the low input impedance (10s of Ω) of C-B is a limitation for many applications. The solution is to precede the C-B stage by a low gain C-E stage which has moderately high input impedance (k Ω s).

Cascode is a technique implied to improve the performance of the analog circuits. The same technique can be applied to transistors and the vacuum tubes to make the circuit better performance-wise. The word cascode is initiated in the year 1939 by Frederick Vinton Hunt's and Roger Wayne Hickman's article during the discussion of voltage stabilizer applications.

Cascode amplifier is implemented as a multiplying mixer in the superheterodyne receivers. For the upper gate, the mixer is fed with the oscillator signal, and the lower gate s fed by RF signal. Then both these signals are multiplied and the IF is considered as the upper drain of the mixer-amplifier.

The common-base amplifier is a topology commonly used in high-frequency circuits. In fact, the cascode amplifier uses a common-base transistor as an output buffer, as we have seen before. A common-base amplifier is shown in Figure 7.35(a) with $R_E = 1 \text{ k}\Omega$ and $R_L = 3.3 \text{ k}\Omega$. Let us assume that $V_{CC} = 12 \text{ V}$ and that $V_{BIAS} = 6 \text{ V}$. The transistor has $I_C = 1 \text{ mA}$, $h_{fe} = 100$, $f_T = 500 \text{ MHz}$, $r_x = 50 \dots$

Folded cascode Opamp

The cascode circuit can achieve the same high gain as the pentode and enjoys the same reduction of Miller Effect. But unlike a pentode, the cascode does not suffer from partition noise, meaning the cascode can be a better choice where low noise is needed. Think of the two tubes as a single device, an ubertube if you will.

All GaN Integrated Cascode Configuration

The circuit in fig. 1 is a Cascode amplifier consisting of a MOSFET input stage (Q1) and a bipolar (Q2) output stage. The Cascode amplifier is biased by a current source established by a MOSFET current mirror pair Q3 and Q4. Transistor aspect ratios (W/L) of the MOSFETs are indicated in the figure.

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
