The original General Standards appeared in the Federal Register on February 14, 1947, as part of implementing regulations for the Hill-Burton program.. History of the Guidelines - FGI

Air flows away from areas or rooms with positive pressure (pressurized), while air flows into areas with negative pressure (depressurized). All rooms are set at negative pressure to prevent airborne microorganisms in the room from entering hallways and corridors.
