Employment and Adults With Asperger Syndrome

David Perkins, Head of Prospects Employment Service, The National Autistic Society. Individuals with Asperger syndrome, part of the autism spectrum, experience particular difficulties with social interaction and communication. These individuals have average (or above) intellectual ability, a strong preference for routines, difficulties in understanding specific aspects of language and communication, as well as other people's thoughts, beliefs and intentions.

People with Asperger Syndrome and Employment

For adults with Asperger's syndrome/ASD, accommodations at work, such as implementing scheduled breaks, requesting written instead of verbal instruction for a task, or using earplugs or headphones throughout the day, can reduce sensory overload and improve executive functioning.
