4.1 What is Receipts and Payments account? As the name suggests, it is a way of summarising all receipts (the cash coming into the parish, such as Sunday giving, special collections, other gifts of money etc.) and all payments (the cash going out of the parish, such as electricity, parish share, giving to other good causes etc.).

If your income is less than £250,000 per year, Receipts and Payments is the easier form of annual accounting for your parish. Unless there are particular reasons why accruals accounts are needed for your parish, new treasurers are advised to choose Receipts and Payments unless they are experienced in accruals accounting.

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£250,000, even if for a non recurring reason, such as a receipt of a legacy, then Receipts and Payments Accounts can not be prepared.

Statement of the Receipts and Payments Receipts and Payments Accounts are a simple form of accounting that consists of a summary of all incomes received and paid via the bank and in cash by the charge during its financial year, along with a statement of balances.
