The higher the capacitance of the capacitor the more energy it can store. A damaged or burnt out capacitor may hold only a fraction of the energy needed for the motor if its capacitance is low.

Locate Output device and ensure that voltage is reaching device and cycling with Input. Ensure that Output device is working correctly (solenoid coil, relay coil, contactor coil, etc.) An Input or Output module can be defective in one area or circuit and work correctly in all other circuits.
