Open the bleeder valve with a brake bleeder wrench, then use the vacuum pump to pump out the old brake fluid. Dispose of old brake fluid in a plastic reservoir. As brake fluid bleeds out, regularly check the master cylinder to make sure it doesn't bleed dry. Continue to add new brake fluid to the master cylinder.
